Mrs. Corrow reviewed the Site Plan Review and everything was present on the map. Mrs. Corrow asked how many parking spaces were needed for the clothing shop. Mr. Murnane stated that they would need 1 parking space for every 250 sq. ft. and since the shop is 42'x77' it was stated that they would need 12-13 parking spaces. Mr. Blaine stated that there are some concerns on how much clothes are brought in and how they would be processed because it has been an issue before. Mr. Wright stated that one of his concerns is the clothing being placed outside and getting rained on. Mr. Robinson stated that they should limit the amount of clothing being placed outside on racks and when closing down for the night the clothing should be brought inside. Mrs. Corrow asked what would be an acceptable inspection of the store by the Code Enforcement Officer to make sure that all conditions are being met. Mr. Williams stated that they could place a condition on the approval for the Code Enforcement Officer to do an inspection on his terms. Mr. Williams stated that they should also place a condition that there are limited sales outside. Mrs. Corrow asked what days she would take off if she would like days off. Mrs. Desotell stated that she would take off a couple days per week but still work on the weekend. Mr. Wright stated that on weekends, people are out looking for yard sales during the summer and maybe Mrs. Desotell would like to change her hours to be longer on the weekends. Mrs. Desotell stated that she would like to have her hours on the weekends from 11-7 and from 3-7 during the week.

MOTION: Mr. Williams made a motion to approve the application with the stipulations that, there are only clothing, purses and shoes for sale. Outdoor sales are limited to two racks only and to be taken inside at night and in inclement weather. Outdoor sales during the summer weekends only. The second building has to be cleared of all clothes by June 1, 2009. Any signs to be approved by the Code Enforcement Officer. Hours of operation will be from 3pm-7pm on weekdays and 11am-7pm on

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weekends. The aisles of store to be clear and meet all fire code requirements. There will be no storage of clothing outside for more than 24hrs. The property to be inspected by the Code Enforcement Officer as needed until no longer necessary. Second by Mr. Wright.

Mr. Wright stated that the Outdoor Wood Boiler is 1000ft from Macomb State Park and he sees no problem with approving the application.
