

School Board Meets August 11th in Community Room

Regular monthly meeting includes setting a budget development timetable

Peru Central's Board of Education is set for its **regular monthly meeting** on Tuesday, August 11, 2009 at 6 PM at the community room, adjacent to the high school's main entrance. An executive session associated with the performance history of particular employees and with collective negotiations will take place soon after the start of the public session. The school board is slated to reconvene in public session **at approximately 7 PM**. It's anticipated the school board will:

- Adopt a budget development timetable for winter/spring 2010;
- Complete a second reading and adopt an updated 8000 [support services] section of the Peru CSD policy manual.
- Launch a first reading of an updated 9000 [personnel] section of the Peru CSD policy manual, as part of the multi-year updating of the entire Peru CSD policy manual.
- Authorize the Superintendent of Schools to sign the agreement with this region's BOCES to sustain into the 2009-2010 school year the long term partnership with career-technical adult education programming.
- Examine monthly program reports and operations reports from administrators and support staff supervisors.
- Set a tax levy and tax rate for the 2009-2010 school year, as is customary at the August monthly meeting.
- Attend to the full range of matters which are customary at monthly meetings.
